


## David's 2017 Christmas



## "A Time for Rhyme"

The 56 pictures can be divided into 14 rhyming groups (A to P), each containing four items. The first member of each group is shown. Two rhyming **names** are to be entered in the next cell. (All people, except for one cartoon character; there are a few helpful clues for some difficult ones) The last cell should contain a rhyming object (no people). The first letters of these objects, taken in order, gives a relevant phrase. There are a few alternative placements.
